*Meyer and her colleagues (2021) found that those working in the healthcare and business sectors were financially rewarded when adding to their existing credentials – salaries increased between 9-11%. Similarly, Bohn and her colleagues (2019) identified an overall economic benefit to credential holders that resulted in a 20% increase in earnings for those with middle-income wages. They also noted that health professionals realize the highest economic returns, particularly for those with associate degrees (up to a 138% increase in salary).
